## CATEGORIES

### *FOR ACCREDITED and AFFILIATE MEMBERS*

1. Landscape Design
2. Landscape Construction (hard landscaping)
3. Landscape Horticulture (soft landscaping)
4. Garden Management (maintenance)
5. Special feature (water, lighting, artwork, fireplace etc.)

Note: your business must be accredited in this area of expertise

The size of the projects in categories 1, 2 and 3, also need to be specified as follows:

- A. **SMALL** – Projects up to \$40,000 (or part project with a budget up to \$40,000)  
B. **LARGE** – Projects over \$40,000 (or part project with a budget over \$40,000)

### *FOR ALLIED MEMBERS*

Any financial Allied Member can enter their business, and be judged for the effectiveness of their support to the Landscape Industry. Three aspects will be assessed:

- Their business premises**
- Any nominated catalogue of product**
- Their website**

### *FOR STUDENT MEMBERS and ANY MEMBER UNDERTAKING RESEARCH*

Any design, built project or research project, completed by anyone who is currently enrolled in a landscape related course recognised by Landscaping NZ

## FOLDERS

A4 spiral bound as follows:

**FRONT COVER** (laminated) – Project name, Entrant name, Best Photograph

**Page 2** Reduced plan(s) showing original scale – Drawings entered into the DESIGN category will be assessed, and must be folded to fit within the A4 format.

**Pages 3 up to 8** Images (no more than 2 per page, both sides if needed)

**BACK COVER** (laminated) – The inside must have the ENTRY FORM with full entry details, and the outside must have – **MAP of Job location (e.g. GOOGLE Map)**

## C D of IMAGES

**FRONT COVER** – Project name and Entrant name – name of entrant also on the CD

**IMAGES** – Up to 15 standard digital images of PC format *PLUS ...*  
– 5 BEST IMAGES to be **tiff files** of 300 dpi resolution for print media

**ENTRY FEES** \$245 for each project entered  
\$100 for additional categories

ONLY cheques will be accepted for the 2010 Awards, made out to:

### ***Points to remember:***

- *While it is our intention that every garden entered is visited, the judges may be forced to pre-judge the projects and choose not to visit those gardens which they feel are not up to Award standard. This illustrates the importance of the quality of your photography and the presentation of your folders.*
- *Ensure your entries are complete – the folders meet the requirements, the CDs have the images as required, and the cheque covers the correct entry fee.*
- *The images become the property of Landscaping New Zealand and will be entered into the 'PIP' files in your name, and may be used for promotional purposes*
- *The entry folders can be collected at the conference – Landscaping NZ takes no responsibility for these beyond the Dunedin Conference.*
- *Entrants (and partners/friends!!) are expected to attend the AWARDS dinner. This is traditionally a fantastic celebration of our achievements, and Dunedin plans to host you in special style in October 2010. This is your opportunity to show respect for our valued sponsors and the Awards and Conference committees, who make it all happen, FOR YOU.*
